INET AWARDED WITHACKNOWLEDGEMENT FOR SOCIALLY RESPONSIBLE PRACTICES IN 2009 AT NATIONAL LEVEL

(*Skopje, 21.10.2010*). Within its corporate activities, INet for the third time gained The acknowledgement for socially responsible practices in 2009. This year's acknowledgement was awarded in the category 'Ethical Management in SMEs for the project 'Implementation of SAP ERP Solution in INet'. The official awarding at national level was held on 20.10.2010 at 'Klub na pratenici' in Skopje.

This year, the award is part of the project 'Social Responsibility of the enterprises in Republic of Macedonia', co-financed by the European Union and implemented by the Ministry of Economy in partnership with: Macedonian Enterprise Development Foundation, The Union of Economic Chambers in Macedonia and the Association 'Connect'. The official awarding was held in the presence of the Minister of Economy, Mr. Fatmir Besimi, prominent representatives from EU/EC and USAID, as well as other eminent guests. At the competition for the National award for socially responsible practices in Macedonia for 2009, which lasted from August 3rd till September 22nd; 22 enterprises applied with 42 projects in 5 categories of social responsibility.

'As a small company, INet is the first company from Macedonia which has accepted the challenge of implementation of the world famous brand, and as a company which cares about good corporate governance, the Transparency is one of the basic principles of INet' – declared Nadezda Dimitrovska, Chief Operating Officer at INet.
